
Kindergarten

Third, Fourth & Fifth Grades

This week in grades 3-5 we have been learning about the circulatory system. Thursday we did an experiment about blood types. First, four beakers were filled with 50 milliliters of water. Then five drops of yellow food coloring went in one beaker. Five drops of blue food coloring went in another beaker. Finally ten drops of green were added to a third beaker. The fourth beaker was left clean. The next part of the assignment was to mix the different colors together. Each beaker of colored water represented a specific blood type. The demonstration was to show which types of blood go together. As each combination was mixed the students were to decide by the color created if the types of blood went together. Of course the yellow and blue made green. Green and blue made an emerald color. The yellow and green made a shade of green/yellow. But when the clear drops were added to each color, the color did not change. This showed how type O blood is the universal donor. Praise God for our wonderfully created body systems!



Sixth, Seventh & Eighth Grades

The story of Caleb by: Xaris
